Notice to voters: If you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by 2 election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials. (See end of ballot for initials.)

IMPORTANT: Use the marking pen provided. DO NOT USE RED INK!

General Instructions

If you make a mistake on your ballot or have a question, ask an election inspector for help. (Absentee voters: Contact your municipal clerk.)

To vote for a name on the ballot, complete the arrow next to the name like this:

To vote for a name that is not on the ballot, write the name on the line marked "write-in," and complete the arrow next to the line like this:

Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote


In the Presidential Preference Vote:

- You may vote for only one candidate.
- · You may vote in only ONE party.
- If you vote more than once, your vote will not be counted.

Choose the party in which you will vote. Within the party you have chosen, you have ONE of 3 choices:

- Vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot in the party you have chosen.
- 2. Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.
- 3. Write in the name of another person to become the presidential candidate of the party you have chosen.

Complete ONE arrow in ONE party.
