Corrections discussed for (a)(3) to correct the spelling of person and add ";unless designated" to the end and section (c) correct spelling of routes. Resolution 2018-01 – Designation of Snowmobile Routes or Trails- A motion was made by Trustee Halpin and seconded by Trustee Wolff to approve Resolution 2018-01 for 2018-2019 snowmobile season. The designated snowmobile trails are:

- East side of Dunn Street to Railroad Avenue, east to County Road M, north to Highway 40.
- East side of Dunn Street to Railroad Avenue, east towards the east driveway of the Fairgrounds, to the footbridge, cross Highway 40 to Johnson-Olson Road, west on High Street to the High School.
- East side of Dunn Street to Railroad Avenue, west to Synergy Cooperative.
- Synergy Cooperative parking lot is designated parking if you plan to visit any businesses on Highway 40.

Voting For: Trustees Wolff, Davis, Jenson, Burcham, Halpin and Stene. Voting Against: none. Motion carried.
