

Regular Village Board Meeting – June 11, 2018

On June 11, 2018, the Village Board meeting was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Village Hall, 613 Main Street, Colfax, WI. Members present: President Stene, Trustees K. Burcham, M. Burcham, Jenson, Wolff, Davis and Halpin. Others present included Chris Larson, William Yingst, Eldora & Merlen Deraad, Steve and Jaclyn Ackerlund, Public Works Director Bates, Police Chief Anderson, Administrator-Clerk-Treasurer Niggemann and Leann Ralph with the Messenger.

Public Appearances – All public was here for an agenda item.

A motion was made by Trustee M. Burcham and seconded by Trustee K. Burcham to move consideration items which have public here to discuss topics to the beginning of the meeting. Voting For: Trustees K. Burcham, M. Burcham, Jenson, Wolff, Davis, Halpin and Stene. Voting Against: none. Motion carried.

Consideration Items

Vietnam Veterans Memorial Dedication – Tom Prince Memorial Park – Chris Larson and William Yingst spoke in favor of having a Vietnam Veterans Memorial Dedication at the Tom Prince Memorial Park. Yingst shared some designs with the Board. He felt that the project could get done in intervals. The first and probably least costly item could be a steel sign that is cut out with a CNC plasm cutter; Dedicated to our VIETNAM VETERANS. Then a fund raiser could be started to raise money to add a granite monument that identifies all of the armed forces and has a nice dedication engraved into it; estimated cost is \$5,000 to \$8,000. Yingst offered to advertise the project on the school Facebook page and Greg Quinn will be contacted as a resource.

A motion was made by Trustee Jenson and seconded by Trustee M. Burcham to approve the request for support for the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Dedication at Tom Prince Memorial Park philosophically and financially. Voting For: Trustees Halpin, Davis, Wolff, Jenson, M. Burcham, K. Burcham and Stene. Voting Against: none. Motion carried.

Public Safety Committee Possible Recommendations

ATV Routes – Public Safety Chair, K. Burcham, informed the Board that the committee recommends allowing ATV routes coming into the Village from County Road M to Railroad Avenue westward to Hwy 40 and Railroad Avenue intersection and then back using Railroad Avenue eastward to County Road M. E. Deraad will take the information to the Dunn County Board in October. October is the month that the County will consider any changes to the ATV routes.

A motion was made by Trustee Wolff and seconded by Trustee Jenson to approve the recommendation by the Public Safety Committee in favor of ATV routes in the Village of Colfax, with the route coming into Village limits by County Road M to Railroad Avenue to the intersection of Highway 40 and Railroad Avenue and back. Voting For: Trustees K. Burcham, M. Burcham, Jenson, Wolff, Davis, Halpin and Stene. Voting Against: none. Motion carried.

ATV Ordinance – The ATV Ordinance will be considered at a later meeting.

FFA Alumni Update – S. Ackerlund just wanted to give the Board an update. The FFA has a total cost of \$40,000 invested into the updates of the hog barn. They have received many generous donations. They are currently about \$10,000 short of the total building costs. Stene mentioned that the Village Board will discuss an amount that they can contribute financially at a future meeting.

Colfax Railroad Museum

Soo Line Park Proposal

The Colfax Railroad Museum is interested in acquiring the land associated with the “Soo Line Park” located adjacent to the Museum’s land off of Main Street. Our intention would be to utilize the land as a park and events area, with a 7.5” gauge miniature ride on railroad running around the outside perimeter of the land. In addition, the Museum plans to install paved parking on the original wooden depot’s land and some of the property recently acquired from the Canadian National Railroad. The plan would be to connect to Park Drive so that vehicles leaving the site would not have to exit directly onto Main Street right beside the crossing gate.

We estimate that the opportunity for Museum visitors to enjoy a small train ride should increase the Museum’s visitor count by 4000 people per year. This would occur during our operating season of May 1 – October 30. A large proportion of the increase would be school groups and birthday party groups that would be hosted at the new events center that will be opening in the wooden depot. We estimate that the increased business in food sales and fuel sales within the Village should be in the range of \$20,000 per year. Our planned event center would also use the land for potential outdoor graduation parties and reenactment events. These activities would bring additional visitors to the Village.

The Museum is requesting that the Colfax Board consider donating the land to the Museum. The property under consideration is irregular in shape and was intended as a park. The Museum would be maintaining that purpose, while providing an economic boost to the Village through development of property we already own. An additional consideration is that the land would no longer need to be maintained by the Village. Roof Updates – The Concession stand roof is finished. The Committee members were able to see it.

Snow Fence – Ball Stop – Estimate from Hayworth Fence \$650.00 if ordered in conjunction with other projects. The estimate says 20' long 4' high silver galvanized chain link fence. The committee discussed that 20' might not accomplish what the Softball Association wanted to accomplish. It appears that the fence would need to be longer than 20'.

Fence around the Light Pole – Hayworth estimated the removal of the current fence and replace with 25' of new fencing that comes in from on the light pole; \$1,850.

Bleachers- Prince is working with a company that is interested in supporting the project financially as a partnership in trade for lifetime advertising on the roof of the bleachers. There are still some items that need to be worked through.

Electrical Panel in the Outfield – Prince wanted to make the committee members aware of the condition of the current electrical panel. A cost to replace has not been requested yet, but it is helpful to see the panel to help with future decisions.

Pass Through Gate – Prince suggested that a pass through fence be installed in the middle of the two fields to get to the electrical panel. Hayworth estimated the cost to be \$550 with other projects.

Fairgrounds

Beer Garden Fence

Estimates were received from two vendors. Hayworth estimated 322' of 6' high silver chain link fence; \$6,580 and also black for \$7,570. Reither estimated the silver fence with the same length and height at \$8,000.

After discussion regarding what type of fence does the committee want to go with and the condition of silver building the committee thought that the park should be finished before the 2019 fair as it will be a 100 year anniversary.

A motion was made by Stene and seconded by Halpin to make a recommendation to the Board to move forward with getting pricing for the beer garden fence with the hog panels to match the new fencing and re-do the roof on the silver building. Stene retracted his motion and Halpin retracted his second.

A new motion was made by Stene to recommend to the Board to move forward with replacing the beer garden fence with the hog panels to match the new fencing, re-do the roof of the silver building and to get new aluminum folding bleachers for the dance area before the 100th anniversary of the fair in 2019. Voting For: Davis, M. Burcham, Stene and Halpin. Voting Against: none. Motion carried.

Pillars at the Entrance

The pillars at the entrance of the fairgrounds also need cement work to mend the east pillar. Depending on the cost, this may just fall under maintenance.

Adjourn: A motion was made by Davis and seconded by Stene to adjourn the Parks Committee meeting at 6:50 p.m. A voice vote was taken and all members voted yes. Motion carried.

CIT – CIT has a few more components to complete and some training, and then we should be all set.

Water Reading Software – Tuesday, we will be testing our reading software and hopefully the upload into Workhorse goes smoothly. The July 1, 2018 bill will be the first billing cycle with the residential water meters installed.

Work Comp Dividend – The Village received a Work Comp Dividend of almost \$6,000. This is generated based on loss ratio for work comp claims. Great job Village of Colfax employees for working safely!!

2017 Audit – The auditors plan to have our audit complete by the end of June.

Operator's License Application Updated – I have wanted to update the operator's license for a long time for the following reasons:

- Duplication on the front side of the application and the back side of the application caused a lot of confusion.
- Reference checks were not checked because there is a background check complete by the Police Chief and the state statute does not give criteria to deny an application based on a reference's statement.
- There was a lot of time spent checking to see if the reference section was completed correctly and then following up to have the individuals make corrections. Then we still miss some . . .
- Individuals that have operator's licenses in other municipalities have commented that our form is much longer, confusing and it asks a lot more questions.

So, I have looked at the state statute and I have requested copies of operator application forms from other municipalities. The State of Wisconsin has standard forms for all other alcohol related licenses, but states that operator's applications should be created by the municipality. I have used parts of three different applications and created one for the Village of Colfax that includes all the information that the Police Chief requested is helpful for him to complete his background check. I did not find any operator's license application forms that requested references.

I feel that the form is brief, but gathers the necessary information. It is clear and easy to read. The form is attached for review.

Vietnam Veterans Memorial update - Mr. Yingst has gotten the steel for the sign as a donation from Steel Towne, value of \$275. He has talked with a monument company and has a rough estimate for the granite memorial of \$2,500 to 3,000.
