

Dave from Nedland has given us an updated bid with a 3 phase motor and a phase converter, that converts from the single phase we have to 3 phase.

His motor/ pump people have gone to this system because they feel that it has been working better on their recent installations that a single phase motor.

It does raise the cost \$1150.00. From the old bid for just a new compactor at \$14,995.00 to \$16,145.00.





Good afternoon Sorry for the long email, but it has a lot of questions answered.

## Kelly from JWR called back this morning.

#### Sebright compactors

According to Kelly, the Sebright compactors that are currently installed at the sites are the best machine in the market. They are great, long lasting machines. JWR has sold 300 units in the last three years. They have a contract with Kohl's. Kohl's uses there machines daily which are also serviced by JWR. Kohl's is in the process of changing out all there store compactors. These machines were new in 2002 and 2003. When they are refurbished they will definitely have another 15 years of life, no problem.

The compactors at our collection sites now were new in 1997 and 1998. The County purchased them in 2018.

Refurbished means: JWR has replaced all worn parts, cylinders, motors, pumps and switches.

#### Breakdowns

Most common breakdowns are the switches. The cost to repair is approximately \$200 for part and \$150 for travel. They have a service tech in the Twin Cities.

Service repairs on the weekends are time and half, but they have someone on call during the weekends.

### Expected Life

Refurbished - 15 years

New - 20 years

#### Sebright Cost New

Approximately \$8,000, so about \$34,883.78.

#### Receivers

JWR does not have any used receiver boxes so the prices quotes are for new receiver boxes.

Kelly indicated that reason that Morgan switched from Nedlands to Sebright was due to the number of breakdowns that the County was having with the Nedland machines. JWR did take the Nedland machines in on trade, but they did not give very much because of known maintenance issues. The most common problem with the Nedland machines is related to fact that our sites are single phase. Because there is single phase at the sites, a smaller pump is used to run the compactor. Basically, compactors run better on 3 phase.

According to Morgan, the reason Dunn County changed from Nedland's to Sebright included the following items:

- The Nedland's equipment was at end of life so they did an RFP. (Morgan does not have handy the age of the Nedland equipment at the time of replacement.)
  - o End of Life was determined when maintenance was being requested more frequently.
  - In additional Morgan indicated that Nedland's maintenance person may not have been completing the contracted maintenance which may have reduced the number of breakdowns. This was determined by calling a third party in to complete maintenance.
- JWR provided cost new and refurbished as an alternative but gave new equipment warranties. With the cost savings, DCSWR decided to move to the JWR equipment because of the great reviews.

I asked if they have had any problems with the refurbished equipment purchased from JWR in the last three years.

• The Downsville compactor had water in the oil which was caused from a tear in the caulk that seals the pump tank. They repaired it and it is just like new.

JWR had provided warranty on the refurbished units of 1 year to Dunn County. So the warranty is expired on the units at the site currently.

#### Johnson Roll-Off

Scott talked with Brian this morning and he said he would purchase all the receiver boxes for \$5,000/ box. He also indicated that he does know that there would be 6 total.

Surplus Equipment Sales

Many of you have stated you are interested in acquiring for your sites. At this time, we have enough information to know what equipment will be available after January 1, 2021 based on the municipalities that have reported. In order to keep the acquisition process equitable for

all participating municipalities that are interested in acquiring surplus equipment, the County is proposing a deadline of <u>November 6, 2020</u> for the receipt of sealed bids for the available equipment, after which the equipment will be sold to the highest bidder. Please address bids to:

All bids received will be opened by the Solid Waste & Recycling Management Board at the scheduled November 10, 2020 meeting. In the event of any ties, the Solid Waste & Recycling Management Board Chair will flip a coin to determine the tie-breaker. Baseline values for each equipment type is provided below, and will act as the minimum bid amount. For instance, the established value for the collection site compactor/receiver units is \$15,000 each, which will act as the minimum bid for the surplus compactor/receiver units. Please note that any compactor/receiver units already installed at your sites will be available for sale to your municipality exclusively for the established price of \$15,000 each. This cost also includes all County-owned accessory equipment and infrastructure already in place at your site. County padlocks will be removed and are not included as accessory items. All costs associated with the removal, transportation, and installation of surplus equipment will be the sole responsibility of the buyer.

#### Extra Receiver Box

We also have (1) extra Receiver Box for the compactors that is used to avoid delays during box switches at the landfill. For instance, if you request to have your receiver box emptied on a given day, there will be a necessary time commitment for getting the box shipped to the landfill, emptied, and returned to your site, hopefully in time for your next business day of operations. Having an extra receiver box in your inventory avoids the possibility of beginning a business day without the ability to operate your compactor.

The minimum bid for the Floater Receiver Box is \$3,000.

The County intends to complete all brush grinding operations at the Boyceville, Colfax, and Elk Mound collection sites during the first week of November. Brush will be chipped into a large mulch pile, which has historically been made available at no cost to interested residents wishing to take it. Unless there are any objections to the mulch remaining at your site for use by your residents, I will not plan to remove it. Raw and composted yard waste materials also remain at these sites, and are also available to residents at no cost. If you prefer that these materials are removed prior to the closure in December, please let me know as soon as possible. Please note that if you choose to continue offering yard waste services at your site, there are specific WDNR requirements, including certifications that must be met for yard waste composting based on estimated annual volumes. Questions regarding yard waste composting and certification can be obtained by contacting Troy Gansluckner at (715) 684-2914, ext. 132, or by email at Troy.Gansluckner@wisconsin.gov

#### Site Closure Deadlines

In order to ensure that all County collection site operations can be properly closed out prior to January 1, 2021, I am seeking your input regarding an appropriate timeline. The County will need several days to complete the removal of all solid waste and recycling materials and vendor-owned dumpsters, and to complete site cleanup and inspections. This means that necessary closures will occur to meet these needs in the last two weeks of the year. We will work with our haulers to accommodate your requests, but this will undoubtedly be a challenging period with these activities occurring around the Christmas and New Year holidays. Therefore, I would like each of you that intend to operate a collection site to inform me of your requests for a deadline for the County to appropriately prepare your site for the transition to municipal management as soon as possible.
